Takes only five solar panes to charge in 2.5 hours.

Jackery claims 4000 charges but looking closely at the specifications it's 4000 charges to 70% of full charge. The specs say 1000 charges to 80%.

ANKER claims 3000 charges to 80%.

Battery's loose their ability to fully charge a little bit each time they are charged. So the specification is misleading as we are not comparing apples to apples. The batteries last about the same amount.
